



Sleep Lab Technologist

Sleep Lab Department – Green Bay, WI

Works under the general supervision of the clinical director (MD, DO, or PhD) or designee to provide comprehensive evaluation and treatment of sleep disorders. This may involve polysomnography, diagnostic and therapeutic services or patient care and education. A Polysomnographic Technologist can perform the duties defined for a Polysomnographic Technician and may provide supervision of other staff.

Associate's or Bachelor's degree in a health-related field required. Registered Electroencephalogram Technologist (R.EEG.T) or Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT), or Registered Nurse (RN), or Registered Polysomnographic Technologist (R.PSG.T.) required

One year respiratory care experience and previous sleep technologist experience is preferred.

This is a Full-time (36 hours/week) position working primarily nights with occasional days to cover pre-evaluations. There is also a \$1,500 sign-on bonus associated with this position.
